Student Art Competition

ARTISTS ELIGIBLE

Competition is open to students, grades 6-12, attending public, private, or home schools in the counties served by the Tennessee Valley Fair.

ENTRY FORM

All entries are to be filled out digitally, ONE entry form with the same information repeated 3 TIMES for each student. Signatures of student and teacher must be added before the form is attached to the top right hand corner on the back of artwork. The entry form should be attached so that the bottom two duplicate sections may be easily removed. Use official entry forms. Entry forms may be accessed at www.tnvalleyfair.org, click on the Contests tab and then the Student Art tab. All forms must be TYPED, artwork will not be accepted if form is not typed. Please verify student's address is current. If you do not have access to a computer, please notify Judy Jordan (865) 679-9756.

ENTRIES

No more than 2 entries per artist may be entered in the competition. (TEACHERS: Please use your discretion as to the quality of artwork.) All work entered will be accepted into the exhibit if it meets all requirements.

All work must be signed by the student and teacher attesting to its originality. If there is doubt as to the originality, the teacher should not submit the work.

WORKS ELIGIBLE

All media will be eligible. All entries must be the original work of an individual student and no copies of another artist's work. Entries must have been completed since September 1, 2015. Do not submit any work copied from published photographs, magazines, or book illustrations or other work. Sculptures should be of a reasonable size and individually boxed. Only individual work will be accepted, no group projects. Home school children are eligible to enter.



DELIVERY & PICK-UP

Entries must be delivered to the Jacob Building (up-stairs) at Chilhowee Park on Wednesday, August 31, 2016, 3 - 6 p.m. ONLY.

Enter at the Lakeside Gate (See Map). Park behind the Jacob Building to unload artwork.

After show, work must be picked up by Monday, September 19, 3 - 6 p.m.

PRESENTATION FORM

- . Judges have urged teachers to take more care with all aspects of presentation form.
- . Artwork must be framed or matted (preferably matted).
- . Mats should be white, cream or black.
- . Framed pieces on canvas boards and canvases must come with all necessary provisions for hanging.
- . All pastels and charcoals must be sprayed covered with acetate.
- . Do not use glass. Glass is excluded from the exhibition for reasons of safety.
- . Do not back work with cardboard.
- . Ceramics must be properly fired.
- . All entries must be sturdy enough to withstand normal handling and display.

Reasonable care of entries will be taken by the Exhibition Committee and the Fair, but the Committee and the Fair assume no responsibility for the loss or damage to entries.



JUDGING

Selections for entry must be made in the schools. Entries violating any of the rules will be automatically disqualified before judging. Final selections for the Exhibition will be made by the art teacher. Award winners will be made by a competent jury. Teachers will be notified by e-mail and entrants will be notified by mail. Judging will be by grade levels: 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, and 12.

PREPARATION

It will be necessary to select and prepare entries before school closes for the summer. Before summer vacation: Have all entries ready with entry form filled in and attached. Please write any special instructions on the entry form or attachment. **When entries have been selected, email info for labels to jordenjudy@gmail.com.)**
