Important Scheduling Change to 2011 Fair Concert Series

Josh Thompson & .38 Special Concerts Have Been Rescheduled

Knoxville, TN (July 14, 2011) – Due to a scheduling conflict on the part of country star Josh Thompson, his show at the Tennessee Valley Fair originally scheduled for Thursday, September 15, 2011 at 8 PM, has been rescheduled to Wednesday, September 14, 2011 at 8 PM.

Thompson has recently accepted an invitation by Country Music Television to join country sensations Luke Bryan and Lee Brice for the 2011 *CMT on Tour* in September and will not be able to make his scheduled performance at the Fair. Classic rockers .38 Special were originally scheduled for the Wednesday, September 14 date, but were kind enough to accommodate this schedule change and swap dates with Josh Thompson. Therefore, .38 Special's concert has been moved to Thursday, September 15, 2011 at 8 PM.
